

EVENT FAQ

What is the Clueaville scavenger hunt?

Clueaville is a unique scavenger hunt through NULU and Butchertown. All proceeds from the event benefit Home of the Innocents, an organization providing critical services to children in crisis in our community.

What is the cost?

\$45 for All-In tickets which includes the scavenger hunt and after party.

\$30 for the After Party only tickets.

What is included in the ticket price?

The All-In ticket includes the scavenger hunt, official event t-shirt, two drink tickets for the After Party, food and live music by Thumper and the Plaid Rabbits.

The After Party only ticket includes two drink tickets, food and live music provided by Thumper and the Plaid Rabbits.

How do we register and pay?

Please visit clueaville.com to register today.

Where does the scavenger hunt begin?

The hunt begins and end at Copper and Kings, 1121 E Washington St. The scavenger hunt starts at 5:30 pm. Plan to arrive a few minutes early to allow for check-in and to pick up your t-shirt.

Where will the scavenger hunt lead us?

Each team will visit 8 sites in Butchertown and NULU. The sites are identified on the Clueaville game card that teams receive at check-in. All team members must stay together during the hunt. The distance is approximately one and a half miles.

What are we looking for on the scavenger hunt?

At each site, teams solve a puzzle or perform an activity to receive a clue. The clues will help teams identify an innocent suspect and the key that leads them home. Teams will also take a group photo to be shared on social media.

Is there a prize?

Each scavenger hunt participant receives a t-shirt plus admission to the After Party. Additionally, teams who visit all 8 sites and return a correctly completed game card to Copper and Kings by 7 pm will be entered in the grand prize drawing.

Where should we park?

Street parking is available near Copper and Kings at no cost.

How should my team dress?

Dress comfortably and for the weather. Teams are encouraged to wear costumes, and a best-costume prize will be awarded to one of the teams at the After Party.

What should we bring?

Bring at least one smartphone with a camera. Volunteers will take pictures of teams at each location. We encourage you to post your pictures on social media using the hashtag #clueaville. Teams will receive clues, game board and pencils to complete the challenges.

What if it rains (or snows? This is Kentucky!)?

This is a rain or shine event. In the event of inclement weather, the After Party will be moved inside. Tickets are non-refundable.

Do we drive our cars for the scavenger hunt?

No, Clueaville is a walking event.

How long does the scavenger hunt take?

All teams must have their completed game cards turned in by 7 pm.

How many people are on a team?

Teams are limited to a maximum of 6 people.
